POINTS OF INTEREST NEAR HOTEL ÚNICO MADRID

1

Museo Nacional del Prado

1900 m

The Museo Nacional del Prado is considered one of the most important art museums in the world, housing extensive collections of European paintings from the Middle Ages to the early 20th century, with a particular focus on Spain. Most of its finest works come from the Spanish Royal Collection, gathered by Spanish monarchs between

the 16th and 19th centuries. It holds a collection of artworks from the 12th to 19th centuries, including masterpieces by Velázquez, Goya, and El Greco.

2

Museo Arqueológico Nacional

700 m

Located in an elegant neoclassical building, this museum houses a collection of archaeological objects from prehis-

tory to the Modern Age. Its exhibitions include prehistoric art, Islamic ceramics, and pieces from ancient civilizations such as Roman and Greek. It is an ideal place to explore cultural and artistic evolution through a variety of artifacts that reflect the history of different times and regions of the world.

3

Opera Gallery

A renowned international contemporary art gallery featuring works by established and emerging artists. Its modern and stylish space invites visitors to discover a carefully curated selection of paintings, sculptures, and digital art, with a focus on creativity and innovation.

9

Fuentes de Cibeles y Neptuno

1400 m

The Fountain of Cibeles, featuring the goddess of fertility on a chariot pulled by lions, located in front of Madrid's City Hall in the beautiful Palace of

Communications building. The Fountain of Neptune, the Roman god of the seas, set against the stunning San Jerónimo el Real Church, is surrounded by two historic hotels, the Ritz and the Palace, both close to the Congress of Deputies.

10

Puerta de Alcalá

1000 m

The Puerta de Alcalá is the most famous of the ancient gates that once provided access to the city, and is still standing alongside the Puerta de Toledo and the Puerta de Hierro. It was the first triumphal arch built after the fall of the Roman Empire, making it the precursor to others like the Arc de Triomphe in Paris or the Brandenburg Gate in Berlin.

11

Parque del retiro

1000 m

Behind the gate, you'll find one of Madrid's green lungs, the Retiro Park, which promises a pleasant stroll near the peaceful Crystal Palace, marveling

at one of the few statues of the Fallen Angel in the world, checking out an interesting exhibition at the Casa de las Tenneras, or enjoying a boat ride in front of the Alfonso XII Monument, which is a popular spot for gatherings on Sunday afternoons.

12

Galería Travesía Cuatro

A bridge between the Spanish and Latin American art scenes, this gallery supports art as a critical tool that offers perspectives on the current socio-political landscape.

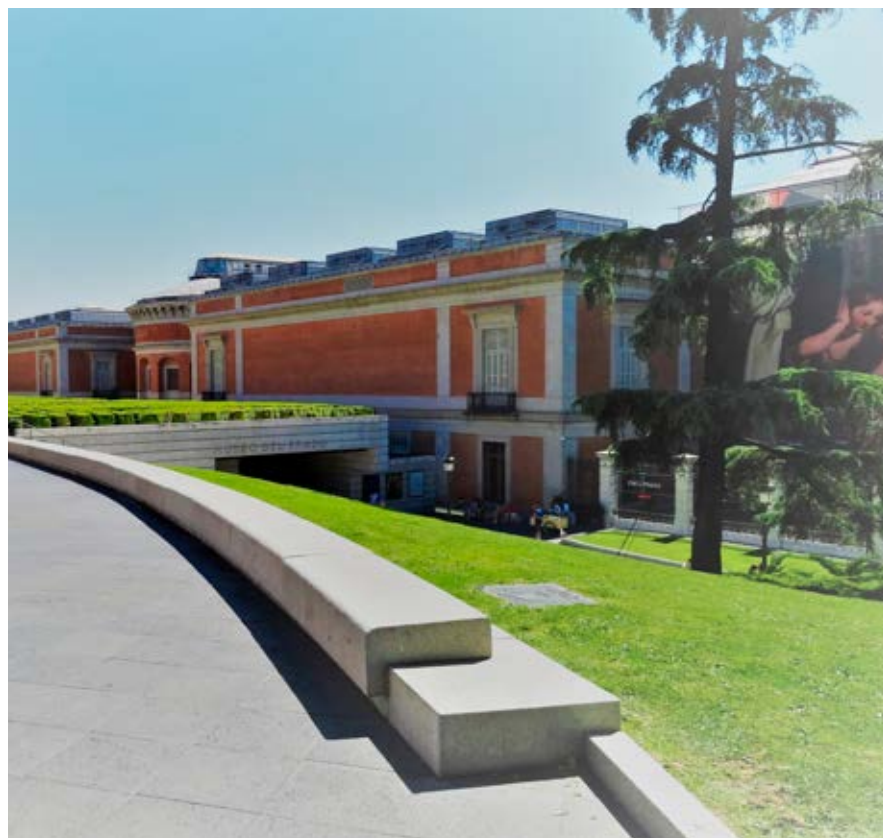

3 Formentor

1700 m

4 Cristina Oria

1000 m

In the heart of Salamanca, this pastry shop has established itself as a reference for luxury haute pâtisserie since its opening in 2013. Its warm and welcoming space provides a relaxed atmosphere to enjoy their sweets and desserts that blend tradition with innovation.

5 Torreblanca

2200 m

A pastry shop founded by the renowned pastry chef José María Torreblanca. Their macarons and artisanal chocolates are perfect for lovers of authentic and refined flavors.

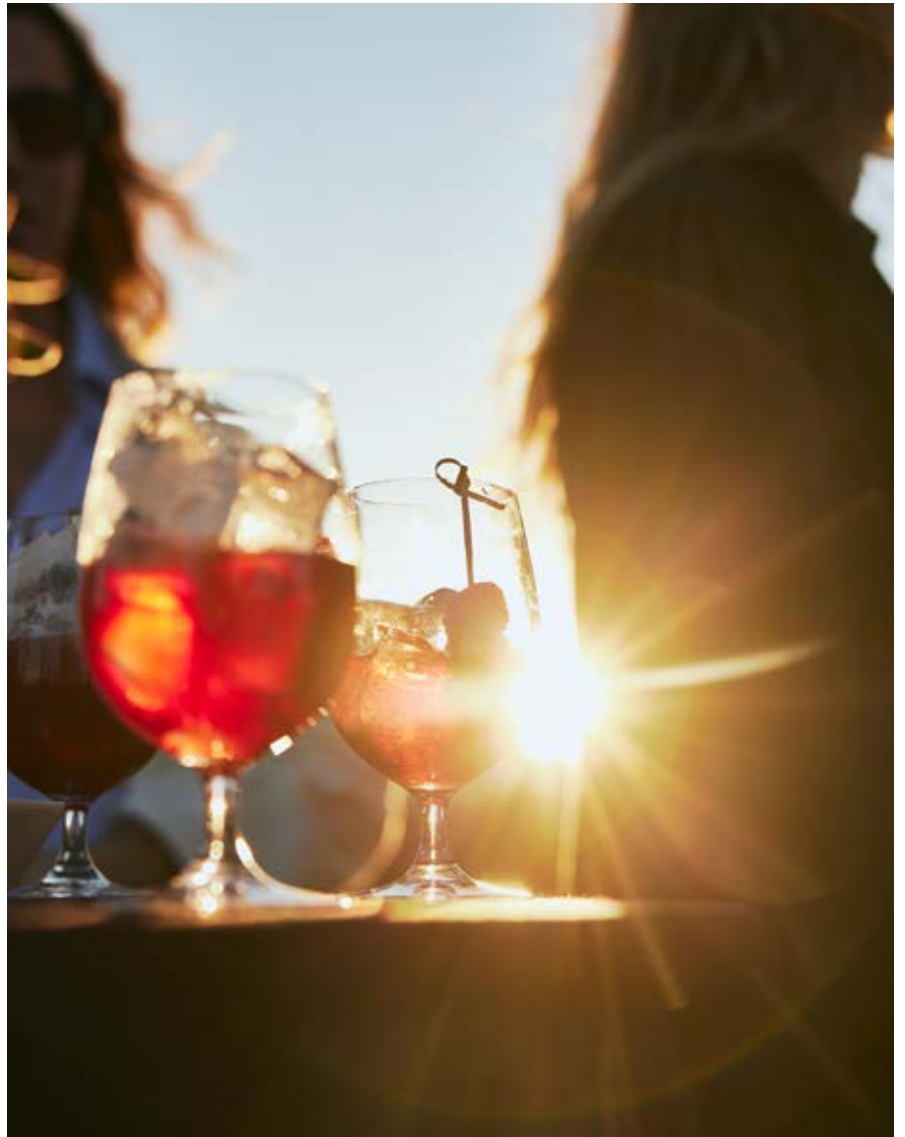

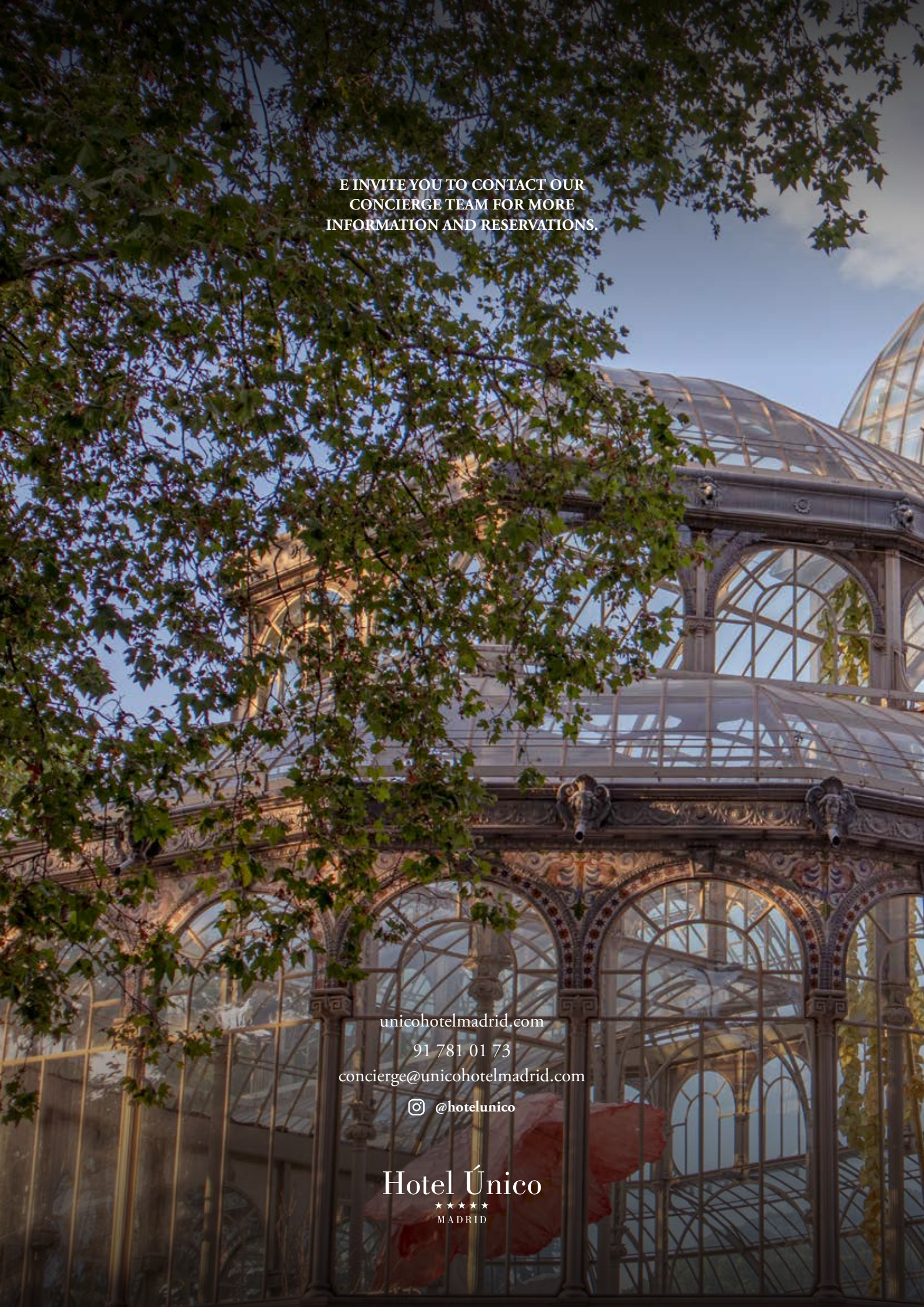
